#### **LOCATION**

Mělice lak eis a man-made waterski venue situated on the outskirts of a small village. The Marin club itself is located on a pine-tree peninsula.

**GPS coordinates:** 50° 2′ 38.64″ N, 15° 37′ 8.46" E

- The site is roughtly 15 km west of Pardubice and around 100 km east of Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic.



- **Driving from Prague:** Take the D11 Highway towards Hradec Kralove and use the exit 68 toward Lízně Bohdaneč. At the roundabout in Lázně Bohdaneč, follow the signs for Živanice-Mělice.

#### **Pardubice Airport**

- Driving from Pardubice Airport: Follow the main route in the direction of Přelouč. In the village of Valy u Přelouče turn right, cross the bridge to Mělice and follow the signs for the E&A Championship.

#### **TOURNAMENT LAKE**

- The courses are laid out on the eastern side of the lake, sheltered from the prevalling westerly winds.
- Trick practice can also také place in the eastern part of the complex.
- The starting dock for slalom is about an 10-minutes walk (3 minutes by car) from the Club. A boat will be available to transport competitors there.

# **ENTRY AND ADMINISTRATION (New Rule 14:12)**

Each Federation shall declare, through EMS, not later than 60 days before the scheduler start of the first event of the E&A Championships:

- The names of the members of its team
- The names of the competitiors entered as "Individuals"
- The names of the competitiors entered as Wild Cards
- The names of the Official reserves

For each competitor registered, the events that they will complete in together with the ramp height for Jump need to be entered.

An entry is considered complete when the Skier's name is registered in EMS and the full Entry Fee Payment has been received.

All payments need to be made by Credit Card / PayPal through EMS. For the Official Reserves, no payment is due at this time.

Any skier entered as a Wild Cardo r Individua lis also to be considered to be a TEAM reserve.

An entered skier may be replaced by different one without penalty, provided that they ave already been entered as a Reserve skier, wild card or individual.

The 60 days deadline does not include those skiers who may additionally qualify **as individuals** through the Weekly ort he Pro Ranking List (if applicable). For those skiers the following deadlines apply:

- 1) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Weekly Ranking List is 30 days before the Championships.
- 2) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Pro Tour Ranking List is 15 days before the Championships.

#### a) Fines for Late Registration.

Any Federation not meeting the registration deadlines will not be allowed to compete until their Federation pays a fine to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. The fines are as follow:

- \* € 25 per skier if the registration is made between 59 to 45 days before the scheduler start of the first event of the Championships.
- \* € 50 per skier if the registration is made between 44 to 30 days before the scheduler start of the first event of the Championships.
- \* € 75 per skier if the registration is made between 29 to 15 days before the scheduler start of the first event of the Championships.
- \* **Double the Entry Fee** per skier if the registration is made between 14 days until 12:00 (competition local time), 2 days before the scheduler start of the first event of the Championships. Example: scheduler start of the first event of the Championships is July 31st, deadline to register skier is noon 12:00 UTC of July 29th..

Two days before the start of the first event the entry lists shall be closed at noon 12:00 (competition local time) and thereafter the order of competitors entered and paid will be finalized and posted. The Scorer in consultation with the Chief Judge should post Preliminary Running Orders 7 days preceding the start of events with the orders clearly marked as "Preliminary and subject to change".

No change in this order is allowed after noon (competition local time) of the two days preceding the start of events except that a team representative may without penalty:

- 1) Withdraw a skier from the competition.
- 2) Replace an injured skier with a qualified official reserve from the same team with the authority of the Chief Judge and before the start of the first event, that is, before the first skier taking part in the first event has started.
- 3) The substitute skier shall start first in the series in which he is qualified unless the draw has not yet been completed.

# b) Team or individual athletes not showing up:

In the event a team or individual athletes (for whom their Federation has submitted a competition entry), fail to show up for a competition their entry fee shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of two days before the start of the competition.

A valid excuse may include a sickness certificate or a certificated injury and should be considered and agreed as valid by the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. All fines have to be paid on-site to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. No skiers will be allowed to start if any due fine is not paid.

If the "valid excuse" is accepted, the money will be refunded by the Organiser to the relative Federation, within 30 days after the end of the competition.

#### **OFFICIAL ENTRY FEE**

- €280 per competitor (regardless of discipline).

From entry fee:

- €40 will go toward official's travel costs.
- €10 will go to the WADA Fund.

Remitting parties are responsible for ALL fees or charges at both ends. Where bank charges or fees have been deducted, Federations/Skiers will be required to make good any shortfall at registration.

# **OFFICIAL SITE FAMILIARISATION** (E&A Rule 14:07)

The final **two days before** the Championships are reserved for Official Familiarisation.

Each competitor who who has paid for Official Familiarisation will be allocated a set number of passes or time, at the Chief Judge's discretion (ensuring equal opportunity for all):

Slalom: 4 passes or 6 minutes (whichever is less)
 Tricks: 2 passes or 5 minutes (whichever is less)
 Jump: 3 passes or 6 minutes (whichever is less)

After the ITE closes (60 days before the event), the organizer (in consultation with the Chief Judge) will announce the official familiarisation schedule at **45 days before** the start. If a Federation does not want to participate, they must notify the organizer and the Chief Judge as soon as possible. Familiarisation times are schduled by event group (slalom, tricks, jump by ramp height).

Any athlete whose time has not been paid for **30 days before** the event or who is not ready to ski at their alloted time will lose their official familiarisation slot.

**Fees:** The maximum cost is €240 per hour, i.e., €4 per minute.

- 30 days before	04-08-25	deadline for familiarisation payment
-	10-08-25	Final schedule

The Chief Judge shall have the discretion to change the start time of team's familiarisation based on extraordinary circumstances.

During the Official Familiarisation period the Chief Judge may allocate any available site familiarisation times but only to skiers who have not already used i tor do not have time allocated.
